



# How to clear Google Chrome cache



It is a two stages process:

- First, clear the browsing data
- Second, restore settings to their original defaults

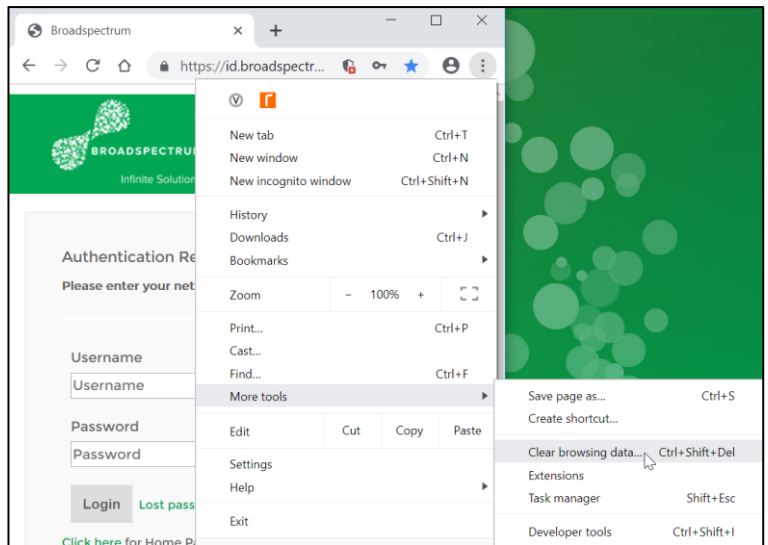
## Stage 1: Clear browsing data

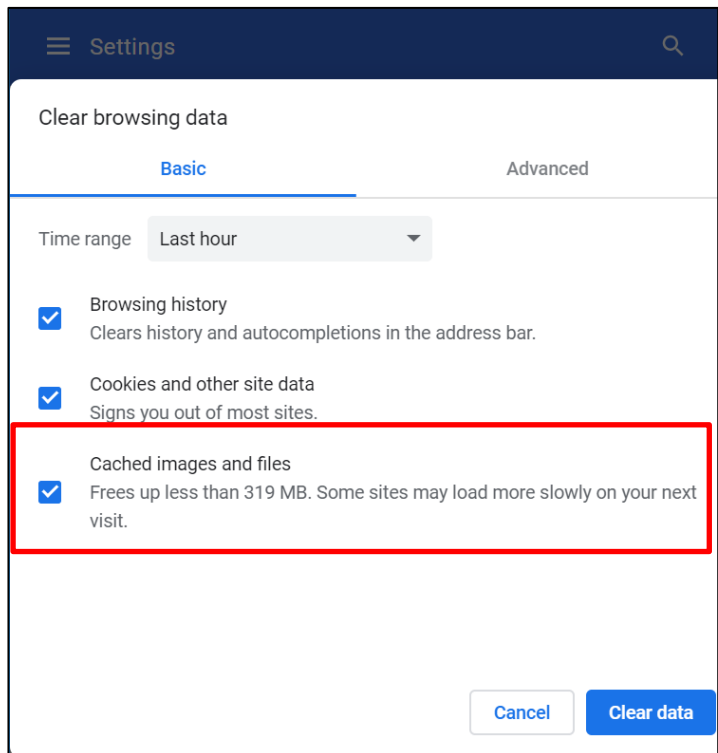

2. Select 'More tools->Clear browsing data'.



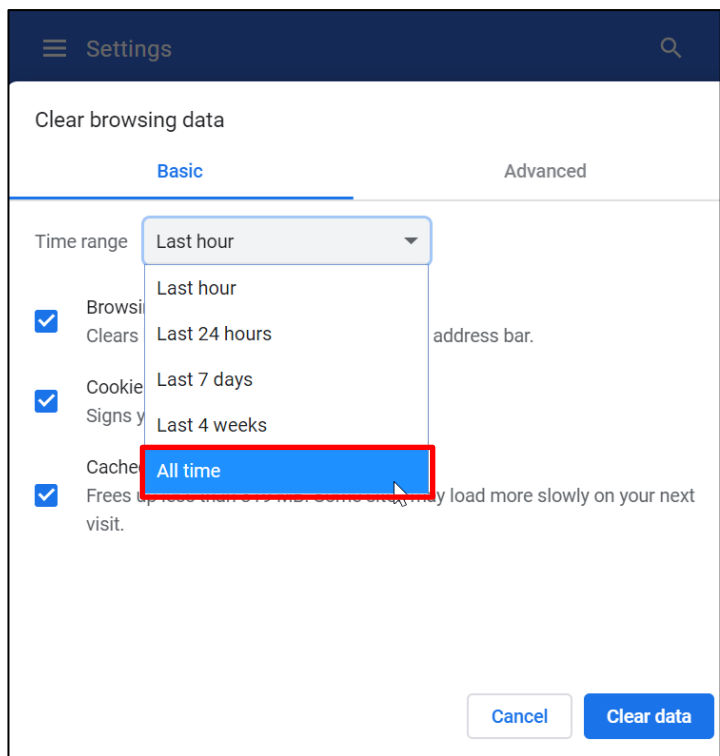
3. Ensure 'Cached images and files' is selected.



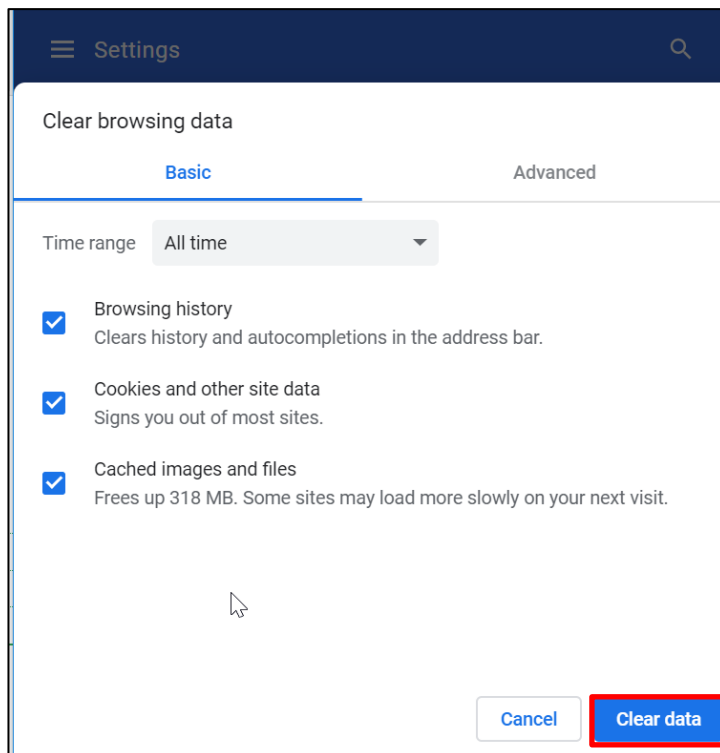
# How to clear Google Chrome cache



- 4. Click the 'Time range' dropdown, and select 'All time'.





- 5. Click 'Clear data'.





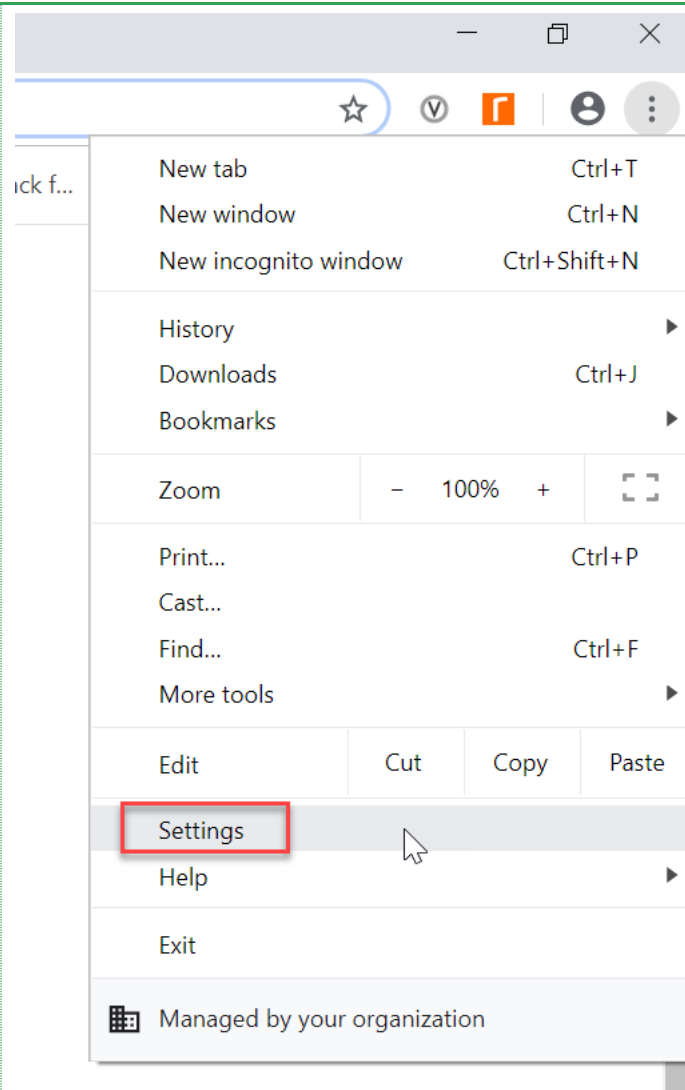
## Stage 2: Restore settings to their original defaults

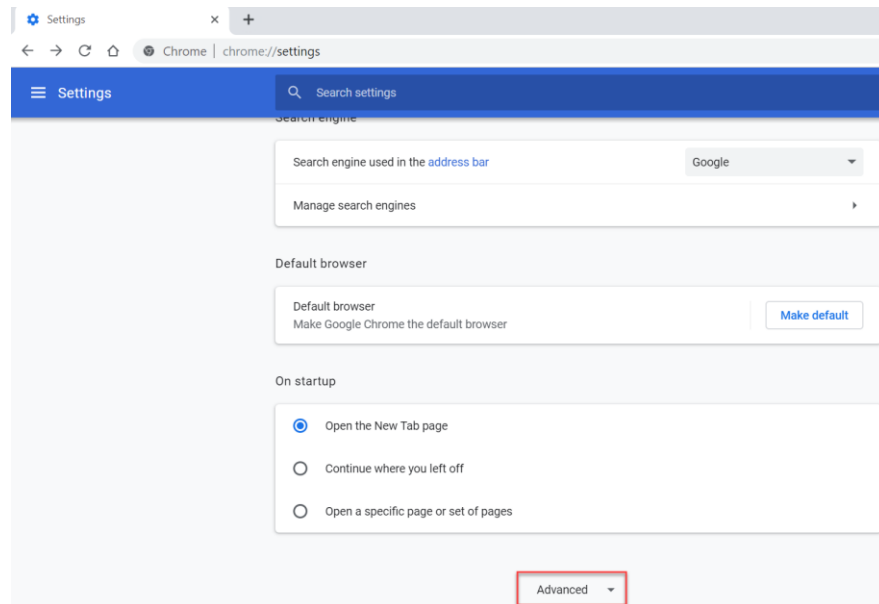
2. Select 'Settings'.



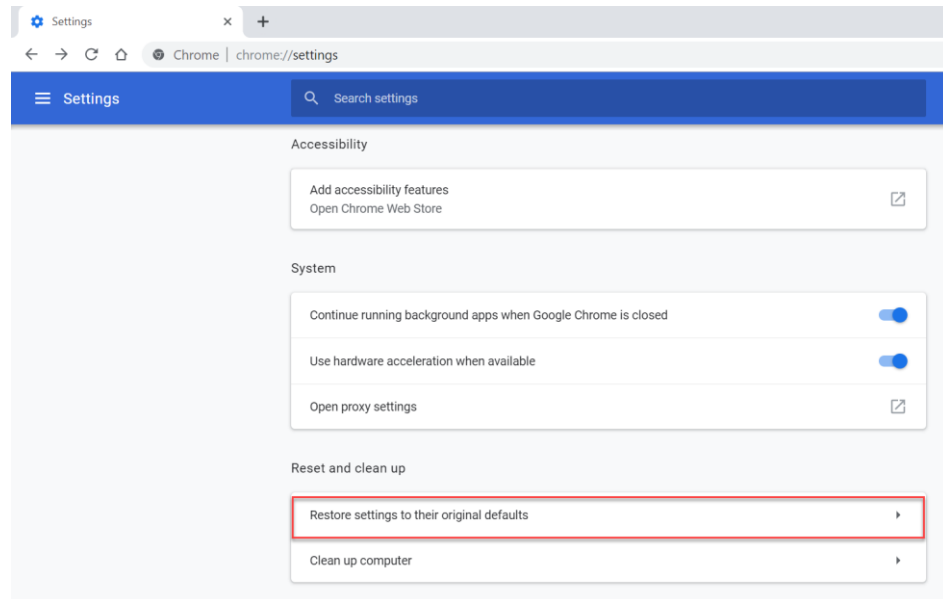
