VISIONSTREAM SIGNS 5 YEAR MULTI-TECHNOLOGY AGREEMENT WITH NBN.

Visionstream Australia Pty. Ltd. (Visionstream) today entered into a new 5 year Multi-Technology Integrated Master Agreement (MIMA) with NBN Co Ltd. Visionstream will construct fibre to the node and fibre to the premises connections across Queensland, New South Wales, Victoria and Tasmania. The value of the first year of Visionstream's contract is expected to exceed AUD\$270m. Additional works are expected to be periodically issued throughout the remaining duration of the contract.

NBN have developed an extensive new infrastructure installation program and we are excited to be a trusted partner for this multi-technology rollout.
